## PREVIOUS FIGHTS FOR HUMAN RIGHTS (HISTORY OF THE CANDIDATE)

History of the candidates and the successes they successfully achieved through their work. The candidates stand out by their decision to actively support the protection and promotion of human rights.

## CRITICAL CONSCIOUSNESS (AWARENESS)

The candidates are committed to the development of a critical and conscious civil society, who knows the principles of human rights and the necessity to promote them. They raise awareness among citizens and include them in the process of advocacy.

## SUSTAINABILITY

The candidates are committed to sustainable activities, as they promote long-lasting effects in society, and they are unique in their work. The activities of the candidates will have a positive, lasting effect.

## AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

The activities of the candidates are related to topics that are interesting and attractive for students and that may find a relation to Italy, enabling the students to deal with their own reality.

## IMPORTANT

Following candidates will NOT fall into closer selection:

- Activities/projects which are already supported by other donors or are part of a major development cooperation project. Also excluded are candidacies of NGOs or other organizations that have a comprehensive fundraising capacity itself and are able to finance themselves without the support of OD.
- Candidates who pursue or promote so-called "indoctrinated" activities. This does not exclude a priori all candidates that take religious initiatives, but those who have a proselytizing approach or are in any way discriminating other people due to their belonging to a religious group, their denomination or their faith.
